



JR. ZOOKEEPER CAMP GUIDELINES

We are so excited to have your child(ren) enrolled in Jr. Zookeeper Camp! Please review the following guidelines to make sure your child is setup for success:

WHAT TO BRING:

- Snack AND Lunch (***PEANUT & NUT FREE***)
- Water bottle
- Close-toed shoes (no crocs, Keens or sandals)
- Sunscreen & a hat
- A change of clothes

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Any and all electronics (no phones, laptops, video games, smart watches)
- Toys or anything that can be used as a weapon from home

Camp Drop Off/Pick Up:

Drop off is from 9:00-9:15am and pick up is from 3:45pm- 4:00pm. Please park on the right side of the main entrance building and enter with your child through the second door on the right. Parents need to sign their child in and out each day. Please allow extra time at drop off on the first day as parents must complete camp waivers. The animal park closes at 4pm, so please pick up on time. There will be fees assessed for late pickups.

Meals and Snacks:

Parent/guardians are responsible for providing a (***PEANUT & NUT FREE***) snack and lunch for their child each day. Please also provide a refillable water bottle. Kindly avoid sending soda and sugary foods.

Camp Attire:

Campers must wear close-toed shoes and weather appropriate clothing. We recommend sneakers, shorts & a t-shirt. Please don't dress your child in clothing that you want kept clean! We will provide a camp t-shirt, please wear it every day of camp.

Personal Belongings:

Items brought to camp should be labeled with the child's name. Items left in behind will be placed in lost and found, located at the front desk in the main building. Items not collected within a 2 week period will be donated. We are not responsible for lost or damaged belongings.

Wellness Policy:

To help avoid the spread of illness, children with a fever, diarrhea or vomiting should not attend summer camp for at least 24 hours. Upon notification of a sick child, parents must pick up their child immediately. Please note, there are no refunds due to illness.

Animal Park Policies:

- Follow instructions of ZooKeepers and camp counselors at all times.
- No running or shouting near animals.
- Be gentle with animals. Do not tap on glass, tease, chase or pick up animals.
- Feed only the food the park provides.
- Never attempt to enter an animal enclosure (unless a Keeper or counselor says it's okay).
